Pyramid Model Infant/Toddler module training will be held in Colorado Springs, Colorado November 3-5, 2010. The content of the training reflects a commitment to promoting social emotional development in all young children but recognizes the need for more intensive interventions when children have significant social emotional needs and challenging behavior. The importance of developing preventive practices and teaching Social Emotional strategies will be woven throughout the training. Trainers will focus attention on what will be needed for fidelity implementation of these practices.
